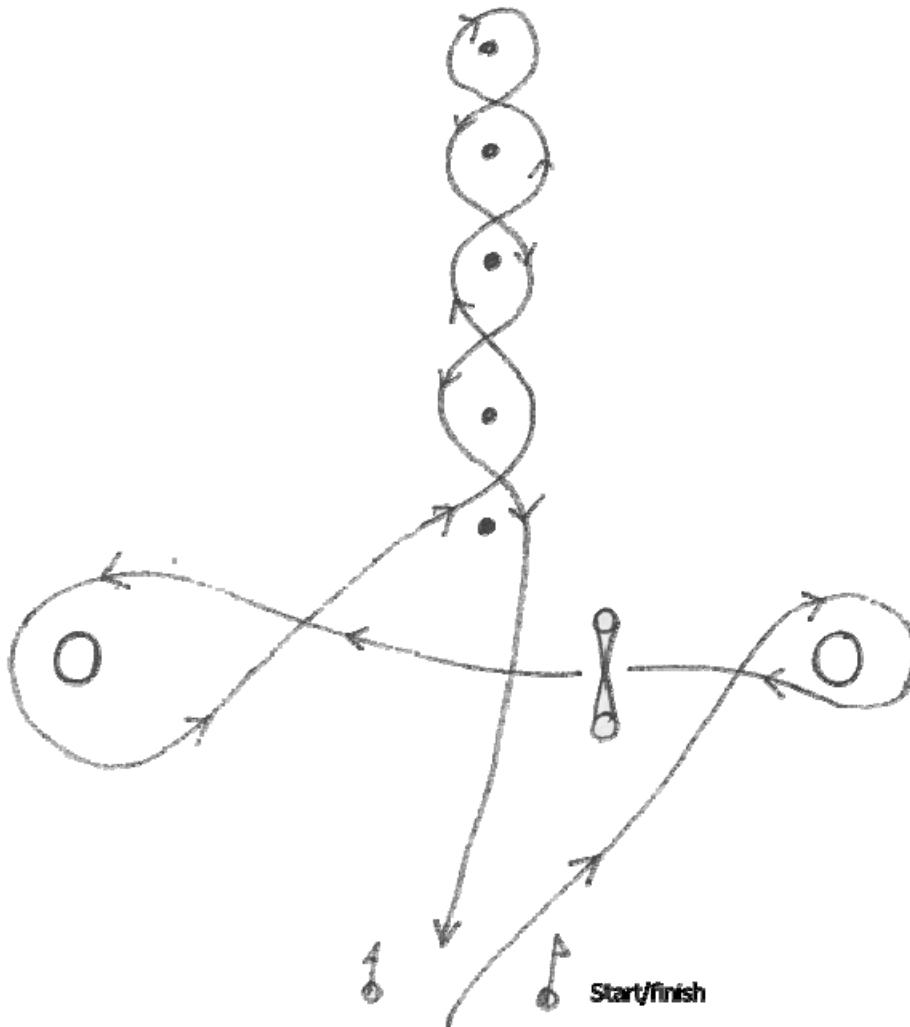
Course Description:

- ❖ through start/finish pegs
- ❖ right turn first around barrel on the right
- ❖ over jump (cross rail or rail on ground)
- ❖ left turn next around barrel on the left
- ❖ back to the centre of the course and turn left around the first peg
- ❖ bend through pegs to turn right around the top peg
- ❖ remove flag from top peg
- ❖ bend back down through pegs
- ❖ put the flag into the container on the middle barrel
- ❖ through start/finish pegs.

Penalties:

- ❖ This will be a timed event
- ❖ Barrel or peg knocked over – 5 seconds
- ❖ Dropped Flag – 5 seconds
- ❖ Take the wrong course – turn around and try again (time penalties)

Conditions of Entry

General Entry Rules

- 1 The Downs Youth and Amateur Show is conducted under the rules and regulations as set down herein first and foremost and secondly by the AHSA as per rulebook. Competitors are responsible for becoming familiar with all sections of these rules available from the AHSA website.
- 2 All horses must be registered with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd, with the exception of horses entered into the Newbie classes. Horses entered in Newbie classes do not need to be registered.
- 3 All horses must be the bona fide property of the Amateur Owner exhibitor's or under a written lease recognised by the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd.
- 4 All entries must be made in writing on forms supplied (or photocopy thereof) and lodged with the secretary on or before the closing date for entries. Registration numbers to be stated for all exhibits on Entry form. A photocopy of the registration certificate MUST accompany entries of all Arabian and Arabian derivatives. NO PENDING REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- 5 The lodging of an entry shall bind the exhibitor to the Conditions of Entry set out herein and the signature of the exhibitor on the entry form shall signify acceptance of the conditions.
- 6 The Show committee shall have the power without assigning any reason to:
 - a) Reject or cancel any entry at any time;
 - b) Prohibit the participation by any person or exhibit in any event or class for which it is entered;
 - c) Cancel or combine any event or class/classes;
 - d) Alter the time at which any class or event is to take place;
 - e) Remove any exhibit from the showgrounds; and/or
 - f) Transfer any exhibit or exhibitor from any class to another.
- 7 Payment in full must accompany all entries. Any cheque or negotiable instrument received or accepted by the Committee will be accepted as conditional payment only, until presented and cleared.
- 8 Entry fees will not be refunded to exhibitors under any circumstance. Entry fees will not be refunded to exhibitors rejected due to non-compliance with Conditions of Entry. Stabling and/or camping fees may be refunded if notification is received by the secretary (in writing) no less than five (5) days prior to the show.
- 9 The Association shall not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.
- 10 Any person causing annoyance by loud comments on Judges' decisions or by unseemly conduct or by insulting behaviour will, after being cautioned by a DACI committee member or the Ring Marshall, be expelled from the showground and the said person may forfeit any awards already gained.
- 11 Any horse deemed not in full control by its handler whilst in the marshalling area or the ring, may be dismissed from the ring at the discretion of the chief steward. Any horse, which becomes free from its handler or rider in the judging arena may be excused from its class.
- 12 Removal of facial or tactile hairs and trimming of the ears and mane is optional, however eyelashes must not be removed.
- 13 If any handler, rider or groom is found using a whip on any part of any exhibit in an improper manner, either in the show ring or otherwise, the exhibitor and exhibit may, at the discretion of the Committee, be disqualified. Exhibits, which in the opinion of the Chief Steward or Judge appear to have whip marks, will not be judged.

General Show Rules

- 14 **Closing Date of Entries:** Where closing dates apply, entries must be either delivered to the Secretary on or before closing date or postmarked with the closing date of entries.
- 15 The committee reserves the right to alter class times on the day as necessary. All changes in scheduling will be announced on the Public Address system and communicated to competitors as soon as possible.
- 16 Entries without their correct exhibit number will not be judged. Horses will be allocated one number for the entire show and it must be clearly displayed at all times by the handler/rider.
- 17 Approved safety helmets must be worn by all riders in all ridden classes. Approval No. AS/NZ 3838 should be stamped on the helmet. Check your helmet as it may be checked on the day for insurance purposes.
- 18 No stallion or colt is to be handled or ridden by a person under 18 years of age.
- 19 Deliberate inciting of stallions to challenge will result in being excused from the class.

- 20 All stallions or colts are to have both testicles descended into the scrotum except where an entire has had one testicle surgically removed and has an appropriate Veterinary Certificate which has been submitted to the DACI Secretary prior to the show.
- 21 A handler, rider or driver shall show one (1) horse only in each class.
- 22 No exhibit may leave the judging area until dismissed or excused by the Ring Steward.
- 23 Any infringement of the Conditions of Entry may result in disqualification of the Exhibit and or Exhibitor, the loss of any or all awards gained and the prevention of any further participation in classes at the Show. At the discretion of the Committee, it may also apply disqualification from future DACI shows for a maximum period of two years.

Disputes

- 24 Protests must be lodged in writing with the DACI Secretary together with a fee of \$50 (cash), which amount shall be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld. Protests must be lodged within one hour of the disputed after the making of the award by the judge, whose decision is being disputed.
- 25 All disputes may be referred to the Disputes Committee consisting of the DACI Secretary, Chief Steward and one (1) competitor. The disputes committee shall, in addition to any powers hereinbefore mentioned, have the power to disqualify any exhibitor from the section or class for the period of the show in which the dispute did arise. All decisions of the disputes committee shall be final and binding.
- 26 Should any prize winning exhibit be subsequently disqualified, the next placegetter does not necessarily obtain the same prize. The Disputes Committee shall decide in consultation with the Judge.

Definitions and Regulations

- 27 **Owners Responsibility:** It is the responsibility of the owner to enter the correct class and to make themselves conversant with the relevant rules applicable to that class.
- 28 **Youth:** A person who has not turned 18 years of age by the day of the show. Youth exhibitors must wear approved safety helmets whilst mounted **at all times**.
- 29 **An Amateur** is one who regardless of his/her equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, does not act as a professional and has been issued with a current Amateur Card by the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited.
- 30 **Amateur Owners** may only compete in classes with their own horse or pony. In Amateur Owner classes, horses and ponies are to be led or ridden by their recorded owners or owned or leased by the Amateur's immediate family.
- 31 It is a condition of entry that all competitors in these classes will hold an AHSA Amateur Card. A photocopy of this card must be submitted with entries.
- 32 A **Newbie** is a rider or handler who is in their first year of showing, or who has never shown a horse a before. Newbies may enter any horse, regardless of breed in Newbie classes only. **Newbies** should wear neat attire in halter classes, and must wear an approved safety helmet and boots in ridden classes.
- 33 Horses in the **Newbie** classes should be clean and neatly presented in safe, suitable tack.
- 34 **Owner** means the person who is noted in the records of the Arabian Horse Society as the Owner or Lessee of the Horse or Pony.
- 35 All **ridden exhibits** must be 3 years of age or over.
- 36 **Ribbons:** Will be awarded to 6th place.
- 37 **Special Presentations:** Will be calculated on a horse + rider/handler combination for the following categories:

- 38 **Championships:** All first and second placegetters must be on hand for Championship Awards. A first place winner that does not return for their Championship class will automatically forfeit their award. In this situation, the second placegetter will be eligible to contest the Reserve Championship.

Showground Regulations

- 39 **Camping:** Camping is available on the grounds and will be charged 'per site'. A charge of \$10 per night / per site is charged by the Laidley Show Society. This fee is payable with your entries.
- 40 **Stables:** Limited stabling is available at the Laidley showgrounds. Bedding is not provided.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I **voluntarily PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this show and the official Rule Book of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

Effect of this Document - I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind. I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.
